## Comedy Carnival – Code of Conduct

Comedy Carnival has a reputation for producing fantastic live shows, featuring some of the world's best comedians. To maintain the high standards of our shows, we require that members of the audience respect the performers, other audience members and our staff.

This means we need to ensure that everyone can enjoy their evening without having to put up with constant interruptions or people talking during the show.

Whilst groups, such as hen parties, are permitted at Comedy Carnival, we insist that they are well behaved, observe our code of conduct and *refrain from the following behaviour*:

### Carrying on your own conversations whilst the acts are on stage.

People sitting nearby should be able to hear the acts and not your group's conversation.

### Interrupting the show or heckling of the acts.

We employ the best, professional comedians who are there to perform their act. If an audience member persistently interrupts a performer, we will take action to stop to it.

### Using mobile phones during the show.

### Behaviour which impairs others ability to enjoy the show.

We believe that the show is the most important part of Comedy Carnival. If your group is no longer interested in watching the show, we will ask you to move out of the main auditorium, and not spoil the show for the other people.

### Restrictions and Conditions:

Over 18s only - proof of age may be required.

Management reserves the right to refuse entry and to remove anyone who continually disrupts the show. Unfortunately, no refunds or part refunds will be given to anyone who is removed.

There is no dress code but smart casual dress is suggested for the nightclub afterwards.
